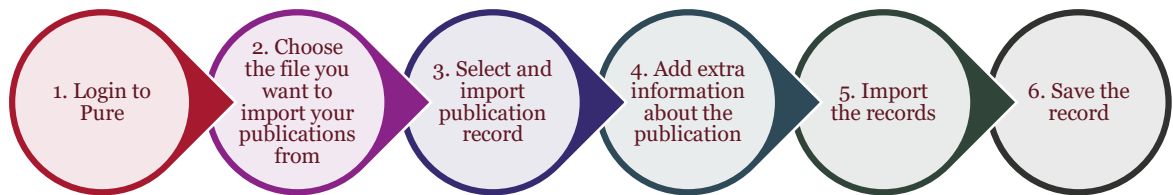


OVERVIEW

RIS or BibTeX files can be downloaded from many databases, web sites and reference managers including RefWorks, EndNote and Google Scholar.

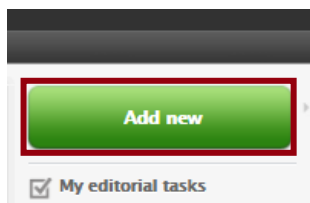


STEPS

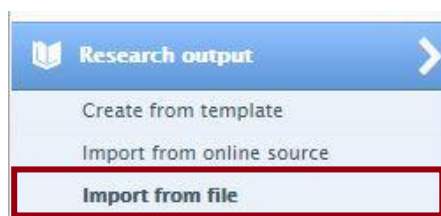
1. Go to <https://goto.mq.edu.au/myresearch> and log in with your **OneID** and **Password**.

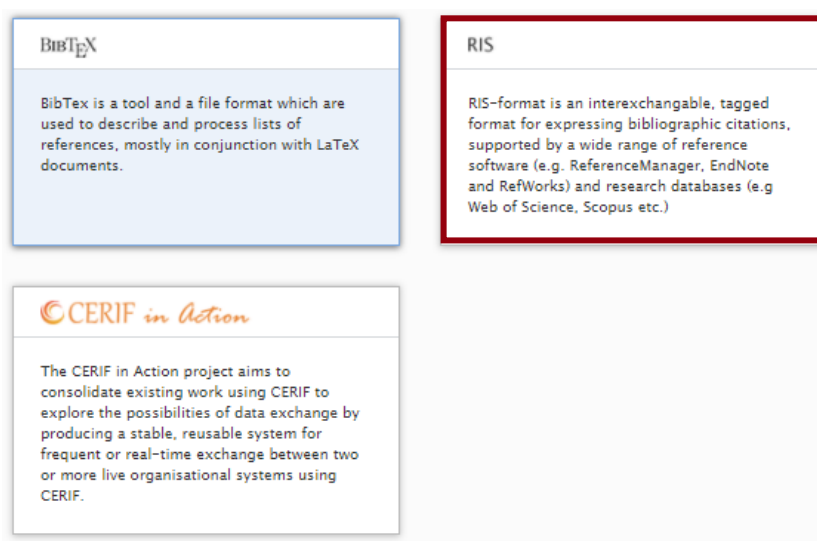
2. Click **Add new** in the task pane.



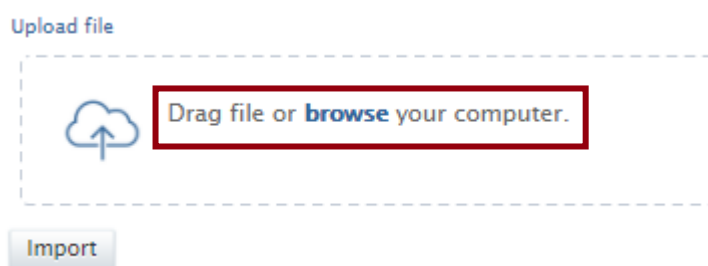
3. Click **Research output** in the left pane and then click Import from file from the list that open below.
